## **Getting Newbies Up To "Glory Quest"-Series Speed**

"Glory" as applied to human beings: Jesus-like \_\_\_\_\_that benefits everyone around us and makes God look good.

#### Words to Use in Sharing

"I believe that Jesus is the true King of the world. I believe he died on the cross to cleanse me and forgive me. Now I'm his student and servant. Would you be interested in learning about him with me?"

Philippians 2:12 <u>Therefore</u>, my beloved, as you have always obeyed, so now, not only as in my presence but much more in my absence, work out <u>your own salvation</u> with fear and trembling, 13 <u>for it is God who works in you</u>, both to will and to work for his good pleasure. 14 Do all things <u>without grumbling</u> or disputing, 15 that you may be blameless and innocent, children of God without blemish in the midst of a crooked and twisted generation, among whom you shine as lights in the world, 16 holding fast to the word of life, so that in the day of Christ I may be proud that I did not run in vain or labor In vain. 17 Even if I am to be poured out as a drink offering upon the sacrificial offering of your faith, I am glad and rejoice with you all. 18 Likewise you also should be glad and rejoice with me.

Making Sense of V. 12: "Therefore" and "Own"

Philippians 2:12 Therefore,...work out your own salvation...

**Philippians 2:9** Therefore [meaning, in light of Jesus' perfect human life] God has highly exalted him and bestowed on him the name that is above every name,

BIG IDEA: Now that Jesus has	completed his	glory quest,

\_\_\_\_\_ your own!

**Hebrews 5:8** Although [Jesus] was a son, he learned obedience through what he suffered. 9 And being made perfect, he became the source of eternal salvation to all who obey him,

**Hebrews 2:10** For it was fitting that [Jesus], for whom and by whom all things exist, in bringing many...to <u>glory</u>, should make the <u>founder</u> [ar-KAY-gos] of their salvation perfect through suffering.

**Ar-kay-gos.** One who begins something that is first in a series, thereby providing impetus for further developments

#### If This Seems Daunting...

**Philippians 2:13** for it is God who works [e-ner-GE-o] in you, both to will and to work for his good pleasure.

"Therefore...work out your own salvation with fear and trembling, for the one who <u>works</u> in you, both to will and to work, <u>is God</u>."
